In 1973, with declining enrolment, the two schools were merged again as Ossington/Old Orchard Public School. OOOPS offers many opportunities for students to discover and explore a variety of interests. A strong curriculum delivery is enhanced by many extra-curricular athletic activities including baseball, basketball, soccer, cross-country, flag football, volleyball and Track & Field. Students can also join the primary and junior choirs, chess club and eco-club.
